Catholic Home Mission Appeal

- where Catholics are few and the Church is poor and fragile -

In your packet of April Sunday Offertory envelopes there is one marked *Catholic Home Mission Appeal*. Every year at this time the Catholic Church in the United States asks fellow Catholics to support mission projects in the United States *where Catholics are few and the Church is poor and fragile*. This *Home Mission* project has been ongoing since 1924.

There are many regions in the United States where the Church is fragile – *the wilderness of Alaska, the deep South, in Appalachia, Pacific islands like the American Samoa, Puerto Rico, etc.* These places struggle with a limited number of priestly ordinations and find it difficult to provide the basic pastoral works of the Church because of insufficient facilities, lack of training programs, huge geographical spaces between parishes, etc. Each year millions of dollars are given to some 90 'home mission dioceses' in the United States.

As is often said, "charity begins at home". It is in that spirit that the Catholic Church asks us to support the work of home missions.
