Another successful Vacation Bible School {VBS}

This past week saw the conclusion of another successful four-day VBS with the celebration of Mass and ending with an ice cream social. We had 31 registered attendees of young persons entering Kindergarten through 5th grade.

The overall theme of this year's VBS was called – MONUMENTAL – and was set in the middle of a desert theme with a different desert animal each day who would teach the kids about the awesomeness of God. **The kids were geared to learn:** that God loves us no matter what; that God is with us everywhere; that God is in charge; that God acts in surprising ways. Each day Scripture unfolded in the story about Joseph of the Old Testament and how God was in charge of his life and used him to help save his family from famine by leading them to Egypt for food. In much the same way Christ so loved us, he died for us and left us the food of the Eucharist for our journey to heaven.

Each of the four days were broken into a number of sessions: daily introductions & conclusions; a bible lesson; a craft time; outdoor time; etc. On the second day we visited St. Leo's cemetery and prayed at some special grave sites all the while teaching our young ones about remembering and praying for our deceased loved ones.

As you can well imagine a project of this scope does not just happen. **It demands a lot of volunteer help.** We had quite a handful of volunteers (young and old) to set up things in the Spirit of Life Center and downstairs rooms.

Beside setting things up there were the various Station Leaders: **Kaaren Bartholomay** for the Scripture lessons; **Sherry Radermacher** & **Lillian Roth** for the crafts; **and Mary Richard** for the snacks.
