RE ATTENDANCE —

Once again the RE attendance numbers are in for the parishes of St. Leo's and St. Thomas and they are looking very good for the past school year.

<u>In terms of perfect attendance</u> at St. Leo's we had 48 out of 160 students who did not miss any class for any reason. That is 30% of our RE students! At St. Thomas we had 6 out of 24 students in K through 6th grade with perfect attendance which is 25% of our RE students. That is remarkable given the fact that COVID took its toll on many school activities. This is fabulous – keep up the great work!

<u>In terms of overall attendance</u> St. Leo's had 82.8% of potential parish students registered in their Religious Education program. St. Thomas had 84.6% of their potential parish students registered in their RE program.
