PASTOR'S NOTES

St. Leo's Feast Day

Tuesday, November 10^{th} is the feast day for the patron saint of St. Leo's Church – St. Leo the Great!

The details of his early life are quite sketchy with tradition saying his father was from present day Tuscany. His education seems limited to the Christian and Latin culture, which makes him the first great Latin speaking Pope and the first Italian theologian.

St. Leo was the 45th pope in the history of the Catholic Church. He was elected Pope in 440 and died in 461. During his years of service to the Church, he confronted many false teachings about both the humanity and divinity of Christ and Christ's relationship to God the Father and the Holy Spirit. His greatest triumph is his writing on what is the accepted and fundamental Christian teaching about Christ – He is a divine person in whom resides both a divine and human nature (known in theology as the hypostatic union).

Pope St. Leo is also credited with saving the city of Rome from the ravages of Attila the Hun in 452. Only two popes have the honorific title of **Great** – Leo and Gregory, who was pope from 590-604.

Our patron saint is a person of great courage, faith, strength of character and intellectual prowess. Let us not be afraid to seek his intercession in our times of struggle and lack of understanding the many conundrums of life.

2020 "Take-Out" and Raffle numbers

Our 2020 'COVID-modified Fall Dinner' of Take-Out Roast Beef and Gravy brought in a grand total of \$2050 from 195 orders of a ½ lb. of Roast Beef and Gravy plus a \$100 donation. After expenses for the roast beef and containers we netted \$1290.26. By way of comparison – in 2018 we netted \$3672 and in 2019 we netted \$3878 from our Fall Dinners. I would say we did quite well given the circumstances of these COVID days.

A huge 'hats off' and thank you to the Tony and Patty Roth family for cutting the meat, making the gravy and packaging each ½ lb. container, and to Mona Frank and Delores Grommesh for running a very smooth distribution system on Sunday morning.

On another note: Our 2020 Annual Raffle brought in a grand total of \$12,880. After expenses and paying off winners we netted \$10,270.03. Again by way of comparison – in 2018 we netted \$12,194 and in 2019 we netted \$12,887 in Raffle ticket sales. We were down this year, but had a very admirable showing.

Thanks so much to everyone who supported this year's 'Take-Out' meal and Raffle ticket sales over the years. It has certainly allowed us to do many facility improvement projects like our recent painting of the interior of St. Leo's church. Again – our many thanks!!

Endowment funds for St. Leo's and St. Thomas

Each parish household received a letter this week soliciting their support of the endowment funds that have been set up to permanently support our parishes into the future. These funds are managed by the Catholic Development Foundation of the Diocese of Fargo with no handling or processing fees of any kind. Each year the parish receives 5% of the five-year rolling average from our parish endowment for parish operations.

In turn, each donor is eligible for generous federal and state considerations (e.g. 40% tax credit). I highly encourage parishioners to check out this form of giving with your tax advisor. Presently St. Leo's has \$60,000 in permanently endowed funds and St. Thomas has a little over \$10,000 in permanently endowed funds. Again your parish support is deeply appreciated.
