The spirit of Thanksgiving Day goes back to our Founding Fathers and their thanks for making 'a go of it' in those first couple years of living in America. Certainly the Lord blessed this part of America this year with timely rains and good weather to harvest a good crop. Thanksgiving Day Mass is a good time to thank the Lord for that blessing and all the many good things that have come our way this past year.

Parish Self Reflection Survey

Parishioners of both St. Thomas and St. Leo's parishes are reminded and highly encouraged to either go on-line at <u>fargodiocese.org/synod</u> or fill out the paper copy of the <u>Parish Self Reflection survey</u> that was mailed to your homes last week. There are also copies available at the back of the church to fill out. **The deadline for that survey is Sunday, November 27th.** This survey is an important step towards the diocesan synod that is scheduled to be held in April of 2024. The data that is 'mined' from these surveys will be the grist for the 16 listening sessions scheduled throughout the diocese in the months of January and February 2023. As we get closer to those dates I will keep you informed of those sessions along with their dates and times.

Communion under both forms

The new church year begins at next weekend's Masses of the First Sunday of Advent. Beginning with those Masses we will return to the practice of receiving both the Body and Blood of Christ. A number of weeks ago Bishop Folda informed the priests of the Diocese that returning to that practice was allowed thus suspending the covid restrictions. Our Mass servers and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) have been given instructions and reviewed our protocols regarding receiving both the Body and Blood Christ at Communion.

When speaking about the Eucharist the **Catechism of the Catholic Church** and the **General Instruction of the Roman Missal** state: "... the sign of communion is more complete when given under both kinds, since in that form the sign of the Eucharistic meal appears more clearly." In that spirit we restart the practice of receiving both the Body and Blood of Christ at Communion.
