This week's Stewardship moment:

PASTOR'S NOTES

Two financial updates —

1) Diocesan Capital Campaign

A capital campaign support long term projects of an organization. These are not yearly expenditures. Our diocesan \$20 million campaign is aimed at: <u>renovation of our diocesan Maryvale retreat center in Valley City; building a priest retirement center; upgrading and susustaining the priests' retirement fund; 30% back to <u>parish chosen projects</u>. This is a four year campaign. Here is where our parishes of St. Leo's and St. Thomas presently stand:</u>

- A) St. Leo's parish has a goal of raising \$289,086. As of September 5th fifty two (52) parish households have pledged \$231,080, which is 80% of our goal and amounts to an average gift of \$4444 from these 52 households. Thank you most kindly for these generous pledges. This leaves our parish with a 'finishing task' of needing to raise \$58,000 in order to make our goal. If you have not yet made your pledge there are campaign envelopes at the back of the church. Over the next couple of months Bishop Folda will be sending a letter to those households who have yet to make a pledge soliciting their support of these very worthwhile campaign projects. Thank you for your prayerful consideration.
- B) St. Thomas parish has a goal of raising \$49,536. As of September 5th six (6) parish households have pledged \$17,520, which is 35% of our goal and amounts to an average gift of \$2920 from these six households. Thank you most kindly for these generous pledges. This leaves our parish with a 'finishing task' of needing to raise \$32,000 in order to make our goal. If you have not yet made your pledge there are campaign envelopes in the social hall. Over the next couple of months Bishop Folda will be sending a letter to those households who have yet to make a pledge soliciting their support of these very worthwhile campaign projects. Thank you for your prayerful consideration.

2) Diocesan God's Gift Appeal - 2024

The God's Gift Appeal (GGA) is the annual fundraising efforts of the Diocese of Fargo to support the ongoing expenses of our diocesan church. The Diocese of Fargo supports over 44 ministries in its service to the 30 eastern counties in North Dakota that make of the Diocese of Fargo: (e.g. - seminary formation of priests; Newman centers at UND and NDSU; Vocation office; training and formation of deacon candidates; marriage tribunal office to process annulment cases; Youth/Young adult ministry office; marriage preparation ministry; Catholic Charities North Dakota; the Bishop's house and Pastoral Center offices; etc. This year's budget for the Diocese of Fargo is \$3,735,942.

- A) St. Leo's parish has been asked to raise \$61,723 towards this year's GGA budget. As of September 30th seventy-two (72) households have pledged \$40,878. This amount to an average gift amount of \$568, but still leaves us \$20,845 short of our goal. If each remaining household were to make a pledge of \$111 we would make our goal. If you have not yet made your pledge there are GGA envelopes at the back of the church. Again your prayerful consideration is deeply appreciated.
- **B) St. Thomas parish** has been asked to raise \$9893 towards this year's GGA budget. As of September 30th twelve (12) households have pledged \$5350. This amount to an average gift amount of \$446, but still leaves us \$4543 short of our goal. If each remaining household were to make a pledge of \$151 we would make our goal. If you have not yet made your pledge there are GGA envelopes in the social hall. **Again your prayerful consideration is deeply appreciated.**
