PASTOR'S NOTES

Upcoming Holy Day

On August 15th of each year the Catholic Church celebrates the **Holy Day of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary** into heaven. This dogma of faith was declared by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950 in an Apostolic Constitution titled *Munificentissimus Deus* [The Most Bountiful God]. In part that Constitution says, "... Mary, Immaculate Mother of God ever Virgin, after finishing the course of her life on earth, was taken up body and soul to heavenly glory."

This is one of three Marian holy days in the life of the Church. The other two Marian holy days are: Immaculate Conception on December 8th and Mary, Mother of God on January 1st. Mary is not God, but she is the preeminent model of discipleship. Everything the Church teaches about Mary comes from our beliefs in her son, Jesus Christ. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "What the Catholic faith believes about Mary is based on what it believes about Christ, and what is teaches about Mary illumines in turn its faith in Christ" [CCC 487].

The Assumption celebrates the ultimate reward of discipleship – communion with God in heaven for ever. This is every faithful disciple's reward. Where she has gone we hope to follow. What distinguishes Mary from us is that Mary was assumed body and soul. Presently all other saints in heaven possess only their souls, but are awaiting their glorified bodies at the end of time. Mary already possesses her glorified body. She is not just one saint among many. She is the pre-eminent saint. What we now see in Mary will be ours in the last of days.

With this understanding in mind, Holy Day Masses for the Assumption are as follows:

Thursday, August 14th at 7 p.m. at St. Thomas in Buffalo Friday, August 15th at 7 p.m. at St. Leo's in Casselton

Religious Education letters

We are doing something new this year for our RE registration. This past week two different RE letters were sent by postal mail to the parents of our RE students for this upcoming RE school year.

One letter was sent to just second and third grade RE parents who will be having children enrolled in sacramental preparation for either Reconciliation and/or Confirmation/Eucharist classes.
