In this last week of August a number of religious education events will be happening! Sunday, August 24th at 6:30 p.m.

Since these grades have additional expectations than regular RE classes, they need to be reviewed in more depth as well as having these parents register all of their children for RE classes. **Again this meeting starts at 6:30 p.m. Please be on time so we can finish in short order.**

Monday, August 25th at 6:30 p.m.

Meeting and registration for all "First Time Families" to our RE program. I will explain our overall curriculum (including sacramental preparation), volunteer expectations for Simple Supper & Hall Monitor, registration fees, go over RE calendar and our RE Handbook, answer any questions, etc.
