PASTOR'S NOTES

10 (Ten) days out --- and then more to come ...

In ten more days (July 17th) the 5-day National Eucharistic Congress will begin in Indianapolis, Indiana. On Pentecost Sunday (May 19th) the Blessed Sacrament started a pilgrimage and procession from 4 different directions in the United States to culminate in Indianapolis and begin our national Eucharistic Congress. Since we live in the northern part of the United State, our route began at the headwaters of the Mississippi river in Minnesota and is known as the Marian Route. To date the Blessed Sacrament of this northern route has traveled through 5 of the 6 dioceses in Minnesota, through 4 of the 5 dioceses in Wisconsin, just the Archdiocese of Chicago in Illinois and recently has traveled through the Diocese of Gary, Indiana and is now in the Diocese of Ft. Wayne -South Bend. During the course of this week the Blessed Sacrament of the Marian Route will traverse the Diocese of Lafayette and finally enter the territory of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis on July 15th and then the city of Indianapolis for the Eucharistic Congress.

Since 1881 there have been 52 <u>international</u> Eucharistic Congresses throughout the world and since 1895 there have been 9 <u>national</u> Eucharistic Congresses in the United States. The last national Eucharistic Congress for the United States was held in 1941 in St. Paul, Minnesota. The upcoming National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis will be our country's Tenth Eucharistic Congress.

As with all such congresses, the emphasis will be on some dimension of our Eucharistic faith and the life that flows from the Eucharist. This congress' focus will be on Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist. Polls suggest a number of Catholics have lost or have a very diminished belief that the Eucharist is the real Body and Blood of Christ. There will be numerous talks, devotions and celebrations of the Eucharist at the Indianapolis gathering. Let us keep this Congress in our prayers!!

So what is coming?? We have just begun the 3rd and final year of this 3-year National Eucharist Revival. **This third year focus will be on being missionary disciples of the Eucharistic mystery**. The Eucharist is the 'source and summit' of our lives of faith and is the gift of nothing less than God's undying love for the world. This *Good News* must be taken far and wide.

To help facilitate and inspire us for the missionary task at hand the Diocese of Fargo will be hosting a Redeemed Eucharistic Congress in Jamestown on Friday, September 6th and Saturday, September 7th. This gathering is meant for all the faithful in the Diocese of Fargo. It is hoped that the fruits of the National Eucharist Congress will begin to blossom in our midst. A number of speakers [Scott Hahn, Msgr. Tom Richter, Julianne Stanz] will headline this gathering. Along with the celebration of the Eucharist there will be a Eucharistic procession, a Eucharistic healing service, praise and worship time along with all-night adoration. Capital Campaign Update

On another front, the Diocese of Fargo is in the middle of their \$20 million Capital Campaign with each of the 125 parishes/missions doing their part to raise sufficient funds to fully renovate/upgrade the gift of the Valley City Maryvale Convent into the Diocesan Maryvale Retreat Center, to build a priest retirement home, to bolster the priest's retirement pension plan as well a provide funds for parish-determined needs/programs.

As of July 3rd thirty six (36) households of St. Leo's parish have pledged \$194,900 towards our goal of \$289,086. Thanks so much for your generosity!! Six (6) households of St. Thomas parish have pledged \$17,520 towards our goal of \$49,536. Again our thanks for your generosity.
