The Diocesan Capital Campaign

As of June 6th the Diocesan Capital Campaign has received pledges of \$11,842,180.98 towards its goal of \$20 million. This pledge amount has come from roughly 60 parishes & missions who have launched their parish campaigns. The remaining 60+ parishes and missions will launch their campaigns this coming Fall in late August and early September.

As of June 6th twenty six (26) households from St. Leo's parish have pledged \$149,600 towards our goal of \$289,086. Five (5) households from St. Thomas parish have pledged \$15,520 towards our goal of \$49,536. A very gracious thank you to all who have made pledges. We certainly invite our remaining households to join their brothers and sisters in supporting this great effort to support the ongoing work of our diocesan church.
