#### St. Leo's RE attendance

Besides a great group of teachers, which I acknowledged in last week's bulletin, another measure of our RE program is overall attendance. 160 out of a potential 192 students or 83% of our potential parish students were registered in our RE program [cf. column 1 and column 2].

Of the 160 registered students, 48 (or 30%) had **perfect attendance** [cf. column 3], which means they did not miss a single class for whatever reason. These are great numbers!! Next week I will have St. Thomas numbers.

## **Lenten Canisters** over the years –

St. Leo's and St. Thomas had another good year with our Lenten canisters, but fell \$1621.86 short of our 2021 all-time high of \$8600+. At the same time our number of RE canisters and contributions were at all-time highs. **Great job, students! Keep up the good work.** [of note --- of the 52 adult canisters 6 persons contributed 55% [\$3300] of the \$5974 total adult canister collection]

It is not unusual for us to receive a few more canisters over the course of the next few weeks. At that time we will give a final report for our Lenten canisters.
